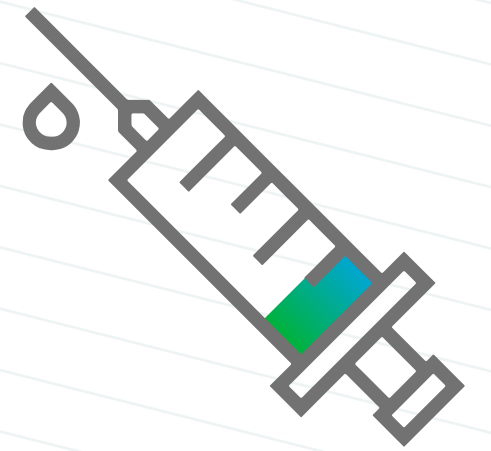


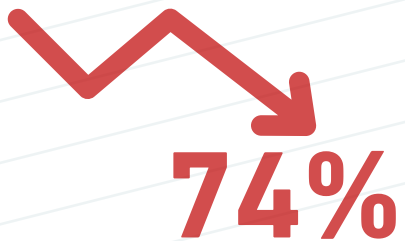
The National Medical Taskforce:

Global studies show a decrease in antibodies within six months of receiving the second dose of a COVID-19 vaccine

Data from Britain's ZOE COVID study based on data from more than one million individuals who received these vaccines showed:

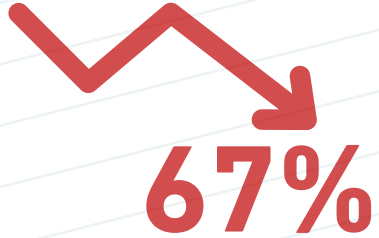


88%



A decrease in the effectiveness of the **Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine** in the month following the second dose from 88% to 74%

77%



A decrease in the effectiveness of the **Covishield-AstraZeneca vaccine** from 77% to 67% four to five months after taking the second dose.

↓ 50%

Protection provided by vaccines for the elderly and healthcare workers may drop to less than 50% by winter.

The above data highlights the importance of taking a booster dose within a maximum of six months after receiving the second dose of the **Pfizer-BioNTech or AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccine**
